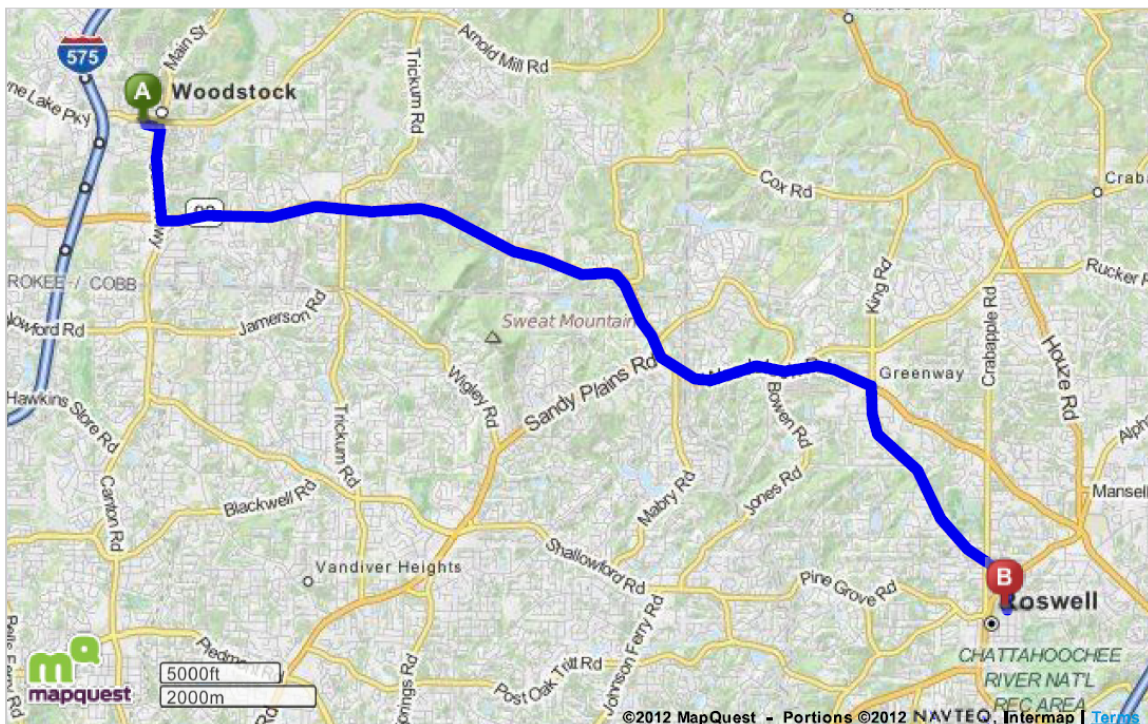

2. Turn right onto S Main St / Canton Hwy. [Map](#) 1.0 Mi
3. Turn left onto GA-92 E. [Map](#) 8.7 Mi
4. Turn right onto Woodstock Rd. [Map](#) 2.4 Mi
5. Woodstock Rd becomes Woodstock St. [Map](#) 0.3 Mi
6. Turn right onto Alpharetta St / GA-120 / GA-9. [Map](#) 0.06 Mi
7. Take the 1st left onto Frazier St. [Map](#) 0.2 Mi
8. Frazier St becomes Forrest St. [Map](#) 0.1 Mi
9. 950 FOREST ST. [Map](#)

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

We need volunteers for dressing room moms, ushers, and lobby help for each show. You may sign up to volunteer for your child's show or one of the other shows. Please see the sign up list at the front desk if you are interested. We are offering two free tickets for each volunteer.

ARRIVAL/PICK UP

ARRIVAL: Each show is scheduled to last approximately 2 hours. Performers are permitted to watch the show from the audience until their specified time to be in the dressing room, or after they have performed.

Please keep your cell phones on vibrate during the show so that we may send you a text if we need to get ahold of you. In the case of an emergency we would make an announcement in the theater.

We recommend that you pack clean activities and snacks for your children while they are in the dressing rooms (ex/ coloring books with crayons, NO MARKERS, clear liquids, pretzels, NO STICKY CANDY/CHOCOLATE, etc.). **Absolutely NO food containing nuts will be permitted at the theater as several students have nut allergies.**

- The first 15 acts should report to their dressing room 30 minutes before the show starts.
- Acts 16 -25 should report to their dressing room as soon as the 10th performance has finished
- Acts 26+ should report to their dressing room as soon as the 20th performance has finished

**Remember to go off the final performance order to be posted the last week of classes in case there are any changes to the preliminary order in this packet.*

Parents may choose to stay in the dressing rooms with their children until they perform. All performers should be picked up from their dressing room immediately after they have finished performing.

Performers are encouraged to sit in the audience after they are finished to watch the other students. We ask that families stay to watch the entire show and not leave early so that all of the performers (no matter whether they are in the beginning or end of the show) have a full audience. We do our best to keep the show moving quickly and at a reasonable length.

GUIDELINES FOR ATTIRE

Musicians

We recommend a dressy outfit for musicians, such as a spring dress or nice pants and top. Dressy jeans are fine, but we suggest a collared shirt in place of a t-shirt.

Female voice students – You may choose an outfit that goes along with the theme of your song. Please use whatever shoes you are going to be performing in during rehearsal, especially if those shoes will have a high heel or slick bottom.

Dancers

Prior to photo week, each class will be given a detailed description of hair, make-up, accessories, tights, shoes, etc. Parents should follow these photo day guidelines for both dress rehearsal and recital day.

TICKET INFORMATION

All seating at the Roswell Cultural Arts Center is general admission. Doors will open 30 minutes before each show time.

-Tickets will go on sale starting **Monday, April 16th** at the studio during the following hours: Mon-Thurs 4:00-7:00 and Saturday 9:00-2:00.

- **Your account must be paid in full** before you can purchase tickets.

-Tickets are \$8 per person

-Performers do not need a ticket to their show. If they are coming to watch a sibling or friend in another show, they will need a ticket.

-Children under 3 do not need tickets if they are going to sit on a lap of an adult.

-Each family has been allotted 6 tickets to start. After May 7th, any extra tickets will be available for purchase. If there are tickets remaining after dress rehearsals, then tickets will be available at the door. We cannot guarantee the availability of tickets at the door the day of the show.

-If you have children in more than one show, you will receive up to 4 free tickets to your second show.
